Subject: Seeks Invitation To APEC CEO Summit 2011

Dear APEC 2011 USA Host Committee and others,

I would very much like to attend your summit. Officially by China's history, I am China's emperor living in exile in the United States of America. I am very embarrassed to say, but I am poor, homeless, unemployed (underemployed with no source of income), and disabled. I have poor vision and no money to pay for an adequate eye examination and special thin-lens prescription glasses. By my own estimate, additionally, I need about \$3,000 worth of dental work. I have a bad back and broken knees (torn meniscus, etc). I am currently on crutches and leg braces and I am not able to walk otherwise. I could use an MRI scan and even a motorized wheel chair.

On May 27, 2011, I wrote to you asking if I could attend your APEC CEO Summit 2011. I am a business person and executive. In 1990-91, I was the chief negotiator for Lester D.K. Chow and Associates, a business and political consulting firm located in Honolulu, Hawaii. I secured Iraq's President's agreement to the Bush White House demands for his withdrawal from Kuwait in 1990. Yet, Saddam's offer to withdraw from Kuwait was refused (ignored) by the Bush administration and our nation then went to war. My resume is online at <http://chinatownhawaii.com/resume/>. I worked as a life insurance company executive and solicitor from 1974 to 1984 and was employed by Lester D.K. Chow and Associates in 1990-91 as a country-to-country political negotiator.

I currently live in a homeless shelter for the poor. I try not to tell people there who I am for security reasons and for my own personal safety.

My family arrived in Hawaii (USA) in 1871 with the coming of my grandfather as a 10 year old boy. No one of any esteemed position desires to beg, yet when one is at one's end is there any other reasonable choice?

I hope that you would consider my application and that President Obama and other wealthy businessmen might decide to help and come to my aid and rescue. It is no fun to be poor and destitute (having nothing at all) living in the greatest nation in the world.



I think that it is highly irresponsible for the President of the greatest nation on the surface of this earth to not reply and to allow a very dignified international celebrity, Emperor and head of state of China in exile, China's current succession emperor, to go poor and hungry in his nation, especially with the APEC Summit coming up in November 2011.

A loyal US citizen holding a love for the

true god and by birth and genetics a true paternal Hebrew, a descendant of Eber.

Younger cousin of the late Premier Zhou Enlai; younger cousin by marriage-ties to the late Chiang Kai-shek and the late Sun Yat-sen; 8th generation descendant of Chang Cheng-kung (Koxinga); 5th generation descendant of Lum Tse Hsu, Governor-General of Hunan and Hubei provinces, Imperial Commissioner in charge of banning opium; grandnephew of the late Henry P'u Yee Aisin-Gioro, last Emperor of China (Ch'ing Dynasty); great-grandson of Chow P'an Lung; China's current Emperor, head of state of China by virtue of title; and China's symbolic Son of Heaven.
