



The Imperial Family of China – Zhou Dynasty

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To whom it may concern:

On May 27, 2011 and again on July 15, 2011, I wrote to the organizers of APEC (<http://himyaosui.wordpress.com>) asking to be invited to their summit. They (some, all, or many of you) ignored me and I was never sent an invitation to the APEC Summit which will be held here in Honolulu, Hawaii, during November 2011. Is this how Americans practice diplomacy and international politics? Where is the fairness in all of this? Do you discriminate and choose who attends and who does not indiscriminately? The rest of the world will learn from your example and likewise will practice unfair and indiscriminate politics. Include your friends and exclude people you feel may have a possible adverse interest to yours. May I strongly condemn this practice and say that this is wrong, unfair, and undemocratic! That such things should never happen in a free and democratic society. Shame on you!

I do not condone such practices and I chastise President Obama and Secretary Clinton for their manipulation of APEC and of other unfair practices going on in the world today. I would not do such things as they do, criminal acts as judged by the standards of U.S. and international laws, as I am a good man and a man who respects political fairness, upright standards, and god!

In 1990-91, I negotiated an agreement between the U.S. Government and Saddam Hussein. Saddam agreed to the proposed withdrawal plan and the United States of America silently reneged. The United States of America all the while publicly saying on American television that Saddam had refused to withdraw! This is a bold face lie as I had negotiated the terms of Saddam's withdrawal! We, then, went in and killed (murdered) two million Iraqis at a cost to our nation of about 4,000 U.S. troop lives.

We go into foreign nations with our American spies, undermine foreign nation regimes with our covert CIA agents and operatives, and then blame other nations for the murder of their own people, when what they actually doing is putting down armed and violent rebellions that our nation had silently instigated. Please take note that regime change is illegal by U.S. and international law! We, also, shoot missiles at foreign government operations, who were in the process of putting down internal rebellions and keeping peace and order in their nations! Isn't it about time for diplomacy and greater fairness in government relations and activities to occur? Meeting foreign leaders and having an honest and upright exchange is productive for the greater world as well as it is for honest and upright business interest. Isn't this true? I am, therefore, in favor of a meeting of the leaders of 21 Asian and Pacific nations as well as business leaders at the APEC Summit.

I hope to be invited and allowed to speak to other leaders of many nations. My interest and existence is not adversarial to the nation of China, but complimentary as a symbol of China's past. It is here that I stand and reside. A man of peace, a Christian, and a man of the true god; China's monarchy in exile and international political negotiator. Currently unemployed, homeless, poor (without any money or means), and disabled with two broken or damaged knees, torn meniscus and other bone damages, mid- and lower- back injuries, asthma, vision problems in need of corrective measures (poor/weak vision in need of corrective

surgery or glasses, plus early signs of glaucoma and cataracts), and very expensive dental needs. My medical insurance will not cover the cost of everything and I may, therefore, not receive adequate or sufficient medical care. I hope that there might be some way in which the U.S. Government can pay for these needed medical costs as I am a foreign head of state living in exile in their nation. My grandfather left China in 1871 to flee from Manchurian persecution and certain death. We (I and my family) are political refugees entitled to official recognition and Secret Service protection under U.S. And international law. Also, too, without money I do not know how I and my family will survive in the United States of America. When I am officially recognized, I should be able to raise money, adequate private capital, for my daily needs and future survival, in this world, from corporate interest and from other world governments. Is not the survival of a good man, a truly good man, a good thing? I am wondering who and how many of you do not want my participation? I come as a good man and a learner. I do not come as a protestor or political agitator.

I hope to be invited to the APEC Summit, in the very least, and I hope to contribute to the peace process by way of my contributions to a greater understanding of this world. Peace is had through not only dialogue and negotiations, but, also, by governments and world leaders having knowledge and, thereby, a greater understanding of the world around them in which they live. Might your organization give this world that understanding and not censor different views and opinions or people. I am sure that many of your organization's summit participants would like to meet me.

paternal Hebrew, a descendant of Eber.

Younger cousin of the late Premier Zhou
Enlai; younger cousin by marriage-ties to
the late Chiang Kai-shek and the late Sun
Yat-sen; 8th generation descendant of
Chang Cheng-kung (Koxinga); 5th
generation descendant of Lum Tse Hsu,
Governor-General of Hunan and Hubei
provinces, Imperial Commissioner in
charge of banning opium; grandnephew
of the late Henry P'u Yee Aisin-Gioro,
last Emperor of China (Ch'ing Dynasty);
great-grandson of Chow P'an Lung;
China's current Emperor, head of state
of China by virtue of title; and China's
symbolic Son of Heaven.

Second-nephew of the late John Magoon,
former president of Hawaiian Airlines,
who is a descendant of Chun Afong,
Hawaii's first Chinese millionaire (the
