Dear APEC 2011 USA Host Committee, APEC Board of Governors, and others mentioned above,

I would very much liked to have attended and been a participant in your APEC Summit, held in Honolulu, Hawaii from November 09-14, 2011. I feel that it is wrong to invite some nations, while ignoring others. Doing so is not fair or just. I should have been invited along with/together with China's President Hu Jintao as he and I, together, represent China and China's entire political, cultural, and historic interests. The king or emperor of any nation is that nation's head of state and not just that nation's president alone. I did not receive a courtesy letter from you and it would have been disrespectful to have turned down the king or emperor of any nation requesting attendance, highly insulting, an unforgivable and unpardonable insult and oversight.

I seek to return home to China and to help that China build on solid ground (upon things that it had not seen and had missed). I am a part of China's communist government and its emperor-in-exile. I think that it was a great mistake to have left out someone as important as I from your summit. A reply as well as an apology is, hereby, politely requested.
