1. I wish to return home to China.

I am a third generation American of Chinese ancestry. My loyalty presently is to the United States of America (as long as the United States of America is upright in all it does and is upright in harmony with the word of God). As China's current and only legitimate emperor (in exile), I wish to return home to China if China's government wishes to have me and my family back.

There are times, perhaps, many, when I feel that this country (USA) does not always live up to its own stated and professed standards and humanitarian goals (many human rights violations, perhaps, more so than any other nation on the surface of this planet). As an upright man and Christian, I was trained from childhood to love goodness and to hate

evil. While, as the Christian bible says, all men are flawed and subject to err, we have an obligation to always try to do our very best and to be honorable and sincere in all we do. To never lie, to put humanity first, and to listen to the dictates of a holy god in all things that we do.

I would like to speak to all of you, government administrators, in China, first, and if you do not like what I represent and if you do not like what I will be doing for your (our) country, I am more than willing to bow out honorably and respect the wishes and dictates of China's government leaders.

2. I am in need of immediate and costly medical treatment in America and the money to pay for this treatment.

I am currently poor and without any resources (without any money). I am homeless living on the streets of Honolulu and, also, and living in a homeless shelter for the poor. I have good health, but I have medical conditions which the U.S. President and U.S. Social Security Administration refuses to pay for in spite of the fact that I am qualified by law to receive.

From 1969 to 1974, I worked as a carpenter (Carpenter's Apprentice). In 1975, one year later, back injuries showed up and I have been permanently disabled ever since (1975 to 2011). In August 2010, my knees gave way due to old age and four years of physical abuse as a carpenter and I have been unable to walk without the aid of crutches. Though I am able to walk with the aid of crutches, I should not be walking as I have torn ligaments in both knees and loss of cartilage in both knees. NIA (insurance company) has refused to pay for the cost of an MRI scan, which is needed as it will show the extent of damage done to my knees. It will allow the doctors to know exactly what is wrong and how to treat my disability. Without an MRI scan, doctors will not know what to do!

Not doing a scan (MRI) is like operating on a person without seeing the injury and extent of the damage. An MRI is imperative and necessary and yet NIA has refused to pay for the cost of this scan. My height went down from 5' 5 1/2" (5' 6") to 5' 4" in about two months and I am in need of a motorized wheelchair. Yesterday, I spoke to about 20 doctors (doctor's offices) and they all did not accept new and/or Med-Quest patients. HMSA, yes, but not HMSA Med-Quest! Though I have Med-Quest, I am beginning to wonder how good is this medical insurance plan and is it paying the cost of medical care sufficiently, so doctors will be able to cover their cost and want to treat patients.

I applied for U.S. Social Security benefits many times, for my back injury, and was turned down in spite of having a legitimate and qualifying medical condition. I, also, applied for Social Security benefits for my knee condition and was again turned down in spite of having a legitimate and qualifying disability.

I have asthma, a bad back, and two bad knees. I presently need glasses, quality thin-lens, which cost \$1,600 plus doctor's examination fees of \$800, and very expensive dental work, \$3,000 to \$6,000, and I hope that my government benefits will pay for these things as I have no income and no savings.

My knees as well as my back pains me daily. Presently, my knees feel like they are going to break and my back muscles are giving me related and considerable pain. I have limited range of motion and I cannot walk, run, and move or turn my knees freely. When I walk my legs, feet, and knee cap, additionally, swells, as if there was some kind of infection there, due to the weight of my body and damage done to my ligaments. Dr. Stephen M. Oishi, verbally, said that I have torn ligaments and possibly bone spurs and fractures, as well as the possible loss of cartilage. Other people have speculated that I may, also, have osteoarthritis.

I am asking for a reply to this letter (from those people named above in this letter and from those named below) and that all of my injuries and knees will be treated immediately (examined via MRI scan, etc, and treated appropriately). I don't think that it is right for the United State government to have a person wait eight months or even thirty-six years for medical treatment. Is this a question of a lack of human rights in America or political football? Exactly who is right, here, and who is wrong!??

3. In 1990-91, I was the negotiator for the Persian Gulf Crisis between President George H.W. Bush and Iraq's President Saddam Hussein.

I successfully secured Saddam's agreement to withdraw and immediately contacted President Bush. The White House (President Bush's office) hung up on my ears, as they didn't want to hear that Saddam Hussein was withdrawing. I subsequently became a non-person in the eyes of the federal government and my healthcare was no longer being looked after. Perhaps, with the new administration in place, a man who promised change from the former regime, I might get the health care that I am legally entitled to get!

4. The Iraq and Libya Wars are illegal and should have never been fought.

Our nation murdered about two million innocent people, Iraqis, who didn't have to die. Saddam had no weapons of mass destruction and a policing action (done by him) was legal by Iraqi and international laws. Our war against Libya and our getting NATO involved to legitimize this war and to get the bloodguilt off of our hands is again illegal, criminal, and inhumanely corrupt! When are these kinds of things ever going to end?

If the U.S. government wants to have me as its negotiator to smooth the waters between Libya and its people, I am most able, capable, and willing. It is both illegal and ethically wrong to bomb Libya and to get involved in the internal affairs of another nation. To label or mislabel what is going on in Libya and to put up a no-fly zone, suggest such, or have NATO do such for the United States of America is not only illegal on the part of the United States of America and NATO, but it is an act of war!

I successfully secured Saddam's agreement to the Bush White House illicit demands, when other more qualified negotiators in Washington D.C. could not! I hope that the US government, per this letter, will allow me to work with Libya's President Muammar Gaddafi for a peaceful solution. I do know that a solution can be found that will satisfy legal international interest.

And I hope that President Obama, if not China's government, will give me that opportunity. The only other option that Obama will then be facing, otherwise, with two murderous and intentionally illegal fought wars, is a criminal indictment of him and his administration and the same for the Bush administration with other nations hopefully calling for his indictment and sentencing as a war criminal in an international court of law (for illegal and intentionally murderous acts). Being a true Christian, I would most certainly follow through with this indictment to see that true justice occurs for the lives taken by Americans and on behalf of humanity and to insure that the true will of the Christian god and honesty is served. Is it not better to do good by the true god, rather than to face execution, later, as Obama and his predecessors have done to another, yet innocent, man?

Once again, I await an illegal President's reply to this letter and to earlier letters. Born in Kenya and was adopted by his step-father, became a citizen of Indonesia, and this person is now President of the United States of America. How many people knowingly participated in this illegal charade? They, too, must face judgment! <http://obamacrimes.com>
