Dear President Obama and Secretary Clinton,

ONE:

I've written over 105 letters to date. Why haven't you answered? Your nation's intelligence reports should verify that I am officially China's current succession emperor-in-exile. And that I am poor, unemployed, homeless, and disabled.

I've always, for all of my life, believed in the United States of America. This is no time to turn me down. Though I am poor and without any political power, I still possess the best and foremost Imperial Chinese heritage (succession and genealogy) that this world has ever seen. I am a good man, a lover of freedoms, a lover of democracy, and I hope to democratize China and introduce the Christian faith, God's goodness and humanity, to whole nation of China. I wish that the press would immediately cover my life's story. I am poor, a pauper, and I could use the press coverage. Publication of my story by your nation's and this world's press will bring my situation to light and help bring about sponsorship for my life's goals and ambitions. Living in poverty is not the answer for me and no one significant can do anything great without having any money. If you chose not to answer my many letters immediately (many posted at <http://himyaosui.wordpress.com>) or chose not to help me, a good yet poor man, I hope that the press gets wind of my situation and publishes it, and the truth of your illegal presidency and administration will meet with its eventual demise!

I am a foreign head of state living in your nation as a pauper. Why is it that you do nothing to help a foreign head of state such as I, China's official succession emperor-in-exile? I do not oppose China's current government regime, nor do I oppose yours. I am looking forward to returning to China, taking my rightful place, and helping both China and the United States of America with their domestic and foreign affairs agenda. If someone great and good, the president or future president of any nation or president or future president of the largest nation on the surface of this earth, asks for your help and promises to help take your nation out of its financial burdens and crisis, why would you chose to ignore this man?

I need immediate dental and vision care, which your nation's public welfare and insurance programs do not cover. If the president of another nation or its emperor and his family was living in poverty and in exile in your nation (good people, upright, and could do much for your people and nation), would you not want to extend a helping hand to these people living in your nation, living in poverty, and with no money at all?

What kind of people are you anyway? More than 100 letters to the you and more than 100 letters to Congress. Tons of back door money (foreign aid) is always being given out to people, organizations, and nations by your government, yet no money for an upright individual and upright royal imperial Christian family from China. We are poor people in need!
